The History of DEAF-initely TEA

In 2008, GHA and Mt. Sinai's ASL Ministry collaborated yet again to form **The First Annual Ladies and Little Ladies TEA Party** (an acronym that reminds us to: Take Time to Encourage and Adorn.) This was the brainchild of two Deaf community-based young ladies, Tamara Taylor and Melisha Battle, Earline's goddaughter. Hats and gloves could always be the order of the day at this semi-formal, outreach event, where more than 250 women gather annually, all adorned for His service and glory. An additional purpose of this event was to provide funding to underwrite a Deaf Revival at Mt. Sinai called "Rooted Hearts." In 2009 and 2010 this Revival featured Minister Curtis Young, a Deaf Black Evangelist from Detroit, Michigan.

In the inaugural year of the TEA, the guest speaker was Sandra Busby, a Deaf woman and former First Lady for a local Black Deaf ministry which is no longer in existence. Our guest speaker in 2009 was our Pastor's daughter and Financial Analyst, Erma Mills Robinson, and in 2010 we were blessed to have Michelle Cox, a Deaf young lady from Haiti as our keynote speaker. To date we have hosted more than 700 women through this one-of-a-kind, truly integrated Deaf and hearing ladies' annual TEA.

On this year, 2011, it is an honor to announce that once again GHA and Mt. Sinai's ASL Ministry will collaborate on the annual Ladies' Tea, this time taking the TEA to another level by taking it to the Community with several scholarships. Over \$2,000 in scholarships will be given from the proceeds of this year's TEA to include: *The Wanda Freeman Friends Fighting Cancer Scholarship, The Candice Daniels ASL Educational Scholarship, The Mt. Sinai Graduating Seniors Scholarship, The Patricia Black Health Care Scholarship, and The Families Helping Families Scholarship.* This year 2 families from our community that are having to deal with juvenile leukemia will benefit from *The Families Helping Families Scholarship.*
